



Summer Camp in England is held at Windlesham, a beautiful private school in the heart of the English countryside, near the seaside town of Worthing. Windlesham

Summer camp is based at Windlesham House School which is set in 60 acres of beautiful English countryside just 40 minutes from Brighton and has many facilities for Summer Camp students to enjoy.

Sports facilities at Windlesham are excellent with an indoor swimming pool, tennis courts, a nine hole golf course, rugby and football pitches, an indoor sports hall for basketball and volleyball and huge playing fields. These facilities, along with a dance and drama studio, 2 large common rooms with TV and video, a supervised library, a theatre for movie nights and an IT room with internet access, play a large role in the fun and interaction students experience during their stay.

Accommodation includes:

- Full board accommodation
- Dormitories with 3 - 8 beds.
- Shared shower facilities.
- Bed linen is provided and is changed weekly.
- Students must bring their own towels.
- Staff clean bedrooms, bathrooms and

common area daily.

What's cooking?

Students receive their meals on campus except on full day excursions when a packed lunch is provided. Breakfast, a hot lunch and dinner are included in the package. Meals are all carefully planned, by the resident cook, who takes into consideration all nutritional value requirements.

Course and Centre
